The property is situated at the eastern edge of the village and enjoys a peaceful rural location within the boundary of Northumberland's National Park. The river Coquet is within walking distance of the property and there are numerous footpaths and bridleways in the vicinity. The famous Drakestone walk is within easy reach.

The village of Harbottle lies in Alwinton Parish, some 7 miles from Rothbury. Harbottle is made up of just a single street, is a one of the most picturesque of Coquetdale's villages. Many of the buildings use pale, biscuit-coloured sandstone. The village is overlooked by the ruins of a 12th-century castle.

The Star Inn is in the centre of the Village and serves as a Community Hub and Information Centre for the Northumberland National Park. The Star Inn has a shop and a newsagents popular by Locals and Visitors alike.
